

GUIDELINES FOR CONTACTING:

ABORIGINAL MEDICAL SERVICES AND COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTRES

QUEENSLAND HEALTH SEXUAL HEALTH SERVICES AND USING MEN'S AND WOMEN'S HEALTH WORKERS OR SEXUAL HEALTH WORKERS AND NURSES

Aboriginal Medical Services and Community Health Centres

Ring the centre and ask to speak to the men's or women's health worker if there is none ask to speak to the sexual health worker or nurse.

Ask the health worker or nurse for an appointment time to get a HIV test.

They may ask you to come in for a discussion about the test. This is called a pre-test discussion or counselling and is the law to help you mentally, emotionally deal with the results whether they are positive or negative.

When you have the HIV test you will be called in for the results.

If the result is positive the Doctor or nurse will discuss the next steps forward to support you to take care of yourselves by monitoring your health and if you want start taking treatments.

The worker will help you to think about types of practices that put you and/or others at risk like not using a condom for sex and how to make a better decision in the future. This is called post-test discussion or counselling

Queensland Health – Sexual health Clinics

Ring the centre and ask to speak to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander men's or women's or sexual health worker if there is none ask to speak to the nurse.

Ask the health worker or nurse for an appointment time to get a HIV test.

The health worker or nurse may ask you to come in for a discussion about the test. This is call a pre-test discussion or counselling and is the law to help you mentally and emotionally deal with the results whether they are positive or negative.

When you have the HIV test you will be called in for the results.

If the result is positive the Doctor or nurse will discuss the next steps forward to support you to take care of yourselves by monitoring your health and if you want start taking treatments.

The health worker or nurse will help you to think about types of practices that put you and/or others at risk like not using a condom for sex and how to make a better decision in the future regardless of the results. This is called post-test discussion or counselling.
