Dorothy Pratt: Apologise or be Censured

The Queensland Association for Healthy Communities calls on Dorothy Pratt MP to apologise to the gay & lesbian community for calling them 'not normal' or be censured by the Speaker of the House.

"If Ms Pratt made these comments about a religious or racial minority, there would be hell to pay" said Paul Martin General Manager "but because the comments were about the gay & lesbian community, she seems to think it's okay."

"We call on Ms Pratt to immediately apologise to gay and lesbian Queenslanders, especially those living in her electorate, for her bigoted and uninformed comments."

"If Ms Pratt doesn't apologise, we call on the Speaker of the House to censure Ms Pratt for her comments. This is not suitable language for a member of the Queensland Parliament."
