fitness/sport campaigns/programs (low competition and fun) - healthy living - a real address on drug and alcohol reduction/over reliance on these in the community as sexual and social lubricants. Mental and emotional health & wellbeing is also needed, including the freedom to kiss and hug in public [still a taboo for LGBT] unlike the straight community who have this as an automatic right to publically display affection. Thus relationships development and growth need support and attention (not sure how though people don't like 'instruction' on relationships????). Employment skills development throughout life (not just young job seekers) - many LGBT still accept low paid positions. Stop leaning on too greatly on homophobia and sexual identity & sexual oppression as the scapegoat for unhealthy behaviours [that's negative framing which reinforces dispossessed marginalised stigmatised feelings] - do something other than constant sexual health risk banter [everyone knows already! - be more creative about sexual health promotion and reduce the over-emphasis medical approach. Also reduce all the attention on SOPV's [the majority don't go to these venues especially in the wake of HIV] and gay pub and drag queen/leather jenny liaisons are quite boring - many LGBT go to straight venues - gay only liaisons while welcoming, of course, for some, are not representative of the majority of LGBT community who generally don't have psychosocial sexual personas they need to demonstrate in daily life, but prefer to just be normal people living in their neighbourhoods in a normal accepting society doing normal healthy things and living life just like everyone else where they live work and play. 'Diversity' in the LGBT community is not the only key. Diversity exists of course, but what the majority of LGBT want is social inclusion where they live and work (the mainstay of their lives), with whole of society not just gay society and club scenes fraternities.

Over concentration in this sexual health risk subjects in reality only adds to community perceptions of stigma directed to LGBT community if all that is peak concentration is how risky our sex is! How good can it be too???? How good should it be???? General community get wind of sexual risks in LGBT people and then to them GAY = AIDS (redneck attitudes are everywhere like this - listen to a UHF radio channel 40 for 30 minutes and you'll find out - some should do a social research study on the language and innuendo in this medium, it has a curious mix of all sorts of social attitudes and "gay" derogatory is a common expression). Over-emphasis on sexual risk education also creates trauma to young (or old for that matter) people who are coming out exploring sexuality - they should be told the facts of course, but more creatively and with an emphasis on elevating sexual freedom and expressionism not de-elevated to risk alone (I'm sure that's not the intent however, but it happens this way a bit, although hard to avoid I'm sure).
